Dear friends and family of SEAN International,

My name is Dr Markus Völker and it is a great privilege and joy for me to introduce myself as the new incoming Director of SEAN International. Many have been praying and supporting SEAN International leadership during this time. Thanks to all of you for this great support.



My family (my wife Monika and our children Sophie, Antonia and Valentin) have had the privilege of living and working in Arequipa, Peru for more than 13 years. I'm involved in theological education in a small bible school and with TEE. Our local denomination has worked with SEAN books for more than 25 years and we can see the great blessing, which they have been to those who have studied them.

I worked as a certified technician for electrical power engineering before I started my M.A. studies in missions and bible. Pastoring a church in Germany and a time as missionaries in Tajikistan brought us to Peru 14 years ago. We work with DMG interpersonal e.v., which is one of the bigger mission agencies in Germany. During my time in Peru, I have had the privilege of continuing my studies, culminating in a Doctor of Ministry in International Theological Education.

Raised in a catholic home, religious traditions have been part of my life since childhood. During an evangelistic outreach at a Lutheran church youth club, I realized that I could have a personal relationship with Christ. This changed my live forever. For many decades, Monika and I have been members of the Federation of Free Evangelical Churches (FeG) where we have both found our spiritual home.

I would like to express my deepest appreciation to Revd Terrick Barratt, present SEAN International Director, as well as to the whole SEAN International team for supporting this change in leadership and for the warm welcome, we have received.

As a family, we will stay on until 2018 in Peru for our children's schooling and for the ministry we are currently involved in. In 2019, we have scheduled a one-year home assignment. Please pray that we will have a smooth handover of the director's responsibilities. I would like to ask for your prayers regarding where we should live after our home assignment and for continuing support as we take on this new venture. May our Lord and saviour Jesus Christ bless each one of you richly. In HIM.


SEAN Trustee Carol Freeman reports:

Joan Newton, 1919-2017



On August 10 Joan Newton, a very special SEAN colleague, was called Home. She was 97.

Fluent in Marathi, Joan served in India for 35 years under BMMF, (later Interserve), ministering to women and girls. Her teaching experience in adult education gave her a remarkable insight as to how extension education, especially TEE with its programmed learning approach, would be beneficial to Christian discipleship and leadership training needs across India.

Later serving TAFTEE's (The Association for Theological Education by Extension) Diploma Programme in Bangalore, Joan recognised how the South American SEAN material, with its tutor manuals, could be usefully adapted for India. Her dedicated work enabled the 6 Books of SEAN's Life of Christ course to become the underpinning of TAFTEE's Certificate Level Programme, resulting in their translations into Marathi, Hindi, Tamil, Gujurati, Kannada, Malayam and Oriya.

Retiring to the UK in her 60s, Joan was co-opted by Tony Barratt to help him in the revision and adaptation of existing SEAN material as well as writing additional courses. I was privileged to join them. Joan, accompanied by Balu, her little dog, mentored me in basic TEE skills.

Joan had a profound love for her Saviour, His Word and India. A wise and clear thinker with a serving heart, she was a wonderful mentor and encourager. She possessed remarkable patience with always that gentle sense of humour and engaging smile.
