He shared, that a while back, he was introducing SEAN's *Abundant Life* course to a church member who ran a small business. The man was grateful, but seeing that the course was very simple, said that he preferred not to continue. Pastor Isaac, knowing that the man had about 25 workers in his business, said to him: "Brother I do think you should continue with this course, because, as it is so simple, it will give you a simple way to share the Gospel with your workers and lead some of them to Jesus". Eventually, after a bit more encouragement, the man agreed to continue his study and eventually completed the course.

Sometime later, he visited Pastor Isaac to share what a blessing the course had been, and that through what he had learned, he had led 17 of his workers to Christ!

The SEAN courses will be reformatted and added to the courses that GOLD Project already offers. This will enable GOLD Project to provide churches with a range of courses at different levels to fulfil their own vision to see church and society transformed as God's people learn to meet him through Jesus Christ in the power of his Spirit by studying together and applying the message of the Bible in all aspects of their lives. TEE in Asia... a new book!

SEAN courses are part of a larger TEE family of training materials that use the same methodology. This is the methodology of *Theological Education by Extension* – or TEE for short. Perhaps it's more easily understood as *Tools to Equip and Empower*, that is, tools for local churches to equip all their members to grow in Christ and serve him actively.

TEE in Asia, published in October 2018, opens up windows onto what God is doing through TEE across Asia and the Middle East. The great majority of the stories in this book come from programmes using SEAN courses, translated and contextualized as appropriate.

- ...Nina from Russia She's such a good example of how God can change people through TEE. In a matter of years, Nina went from being a mess in all the areas of her life to being a minister who trains people to train others.
- ...a house church pastor from China Through this great tool we know that God loves the Chinese church and that he chooses us. We know we are not worthy, but the Life of Christ courses have built up our life. The Bible is no longer theory, it has become a life application...
- ...Aiman from Kygyzstan But after the first lesson I understood that I am a child of God, I belong to Him, and nobody and nothing can ever take me from his family. That took away my fear.
